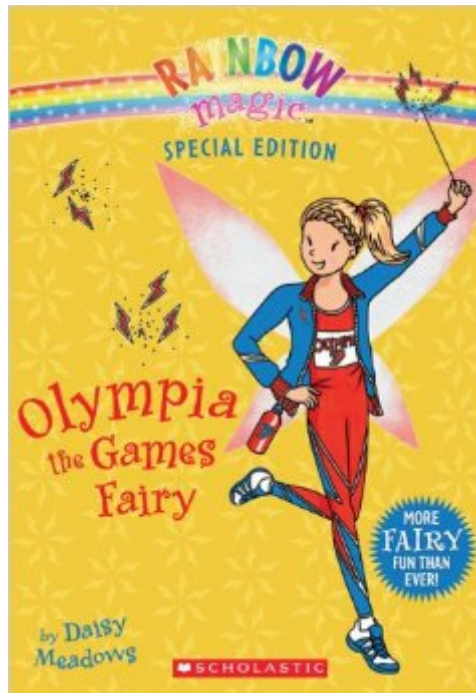

My daughter and I read this book in 3 nights! She loved it! She especially loved the "find the code letters on the sneakers" so she really paid attention. This is a chapter book- but it has drawings on almost every page. That helped keep her attention, too. It was simple enough that she could read it- but she preferred that I read most of it. (She is going into 1st grade soon.) It didn't have many characters, so it was easy to keep up with everyone. This was our first Daisy Meadow's book to

read. We will be buying more- or checking them out from the library.

Like all other rainbow fairies books, this one lacks originality. It's the same story you've read in every Rainbow Fairy book to date. A fairy has lost her special trinket and the two girls must find it while being thwarted by goblins. Luckily my daughter is finally tiring of these repetitive books.
