

As a long term Bell System employee when divestiture took place in 1984, I was pre-inclined to really like this book...as although good did come out of the breakup (mostly faster rollouts of emerging technologies), lots was lost, especially at the expense of customers who had to become knowledgeable in telecommunications as they worked their way through different vendors whenever they had a problem. But...26 years after divestiture, this book is really dated. It accurately depicts some of the issues in the time immediately after divestiture...most of which are no longer valid. So if you want to read a book as a historical reference into divestiture and the immediate ramifications, have at it. BUT: Bottom line, I felt that the authors were spending a lot of time justifying their own actions and beliefs...and I was predisposed to like it! Someone who wasn't a Bell System fan to begin with? Don't waste your time, you'll just get aggravated.

Everyone should read this to understand what happened and that "big is not always bad). Good reading!

A must read for anybody wanting to know how greed and ignorance destroyed the best telephone system in the world. It starts with a history of the formation of the Bell System, the people involved,
